8th Grade Class Party on Friday, May 17th from 5:30-7:00 pm

The 8th Grade Class Party Committee is putting the final touches on the plans. It will be at the Hart Campus and students need to check in by 5:30 pm and need to remain for the entire event. Only students with signed permission slips will be allowed. The Party Committee is asking for a \$25 donation for this event.

Field Trip to Six Flags will be on Wednesday, May 29

The trip this year will be on **Wednesday, May 29.** A Field Trip Authorization, Emergency Medical Information form and Authorization and Liability Waiver forms are attached. The donation cost for the trip is \$135.00 which covers bus transportation, lunch (provided by the park), and admission to the park. If you have a Season Pass, your donation cost will be \$100.00 and your student must bring the pass with them to the park on May 29. If you require a vegetarian meal or have a Season Pass please write it on the Field Trip form. We will send out more information prior to the event.

This donation is non-refundable due to the prepayment requirements for use of park facilities and buses. Donations can be made either through Future Fund or check to Hart Middle School. CASH will not be accepted. All forms with donation receipt or check should be turned into the office by the March 27 deadline. Due to the prepayment requirement of the bus company and Six Flags, NO payment or forms will be accepted after the March 27 deadline. All checks/money orders should be made payable to Hart Middle School. If we do not receive enough donations to pay for the trip we will have to cancel.

Please be sure that your student returns the following items on or before Wednesday, March 27.

- o Field Trip Authorization Form with parent/guardian signature.
- o **Emergency Medical Form** with parent/guardian signature.
- A check/money order or credit/debit card (cash will not be accepted) can be used for your donation in the amount of \$135.00/\$100.00 with Season Pass (Please make check/money order payable to <u>Hart Middle School</u> and write your child's full name and ID # in the lower left hand corner of the check). If using a credit/debit card go to https://hart.futurefund.com/store
- Authorization and Liability Waiver Forms with initials and signatures.

Completed forms & donations must be returned to Mrs. Garrett in the front office by **Wednesday, March 27**.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT RETURN THE REQUIRED PAPERWORK BEFORE THE DEADLINE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND. DUE TO THE PREPAYMENT REQUIREMENT BY THE BUS COMPANY AND SIX FLAGS NO PAYMENTS OR FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE MARCH 27 DEADLINE.

On the day of the trip, students are to arrive at school at 8:45 a.m. and report to their 1st period class. **(Be on time!)** Buses will leave Hart **promptly** at 9 a.m. Buses will arrive back at school between 4:00 and 4:15 p.m. All students must ride the bus to and from Six Flags. Students must provide their own transportation home from school after the return to Hart. Hart staff and cleared adult volunteers will be chaperoning the trip. All school rules will apply while at the park. Non-compliance could result in non-participation of students in the promotion ceremony on Thursday, May 30.

Students who choose not to participate, or who are not eligible to participate in the trip, will be required to attend school at the regular time 9:36 am-3:00 pm.

The Promotion Ceremony will be held at Hart Middle School on Thursday, May 30 starting at 5:00 p.m. No tickets are necessary for the event. Students should arrive by 4:15 pm to line up. Nice dresses, skirts, pants, capris or dressy long shorts. No board shorts. Shirts with a collar. Ties okay. No strapless or backless dresses or shirts. No hats.

This is not a formal event. If you have any doubt about your outfit check with an administrator for prior approval. We will send out more information prior to the event.

And finally, **May 31** is the last day of school. All students are expected to be in school for the Minimum Day. No backpacks. Small bags for carrying pens/pencils for yearbook signing only.

END OF THE YEAR EXPECTATIONS for 8th GRADERS

To be eligible to participate in the year-end activities, a **STUDENT MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING:**

I. ACADEMIC CRITERIA

Keeping grades up during the last two quarters is very important in preparing for high school where students must pass all classes to receive credits to graduate. Students must pass their classes with a "D" or above for the semester to earn credits in high school. We also want all our middle school students to pass all their classes to create positive habits moving forward.

II. BEHAVIOR CRITERIA

A. Discipline

Students must exhibit acceptable school citizenship and behavior through the final quarter. **Students who are suspended may lose 8th grade privileges as outlined below**. Students who are referred to the office for multiple behavioral infractions may also lose their 8th grade privileges. This is especially true if there are safety concerns such as fighting, bullying, etc. Final decision is at the discretion of the administration.

Suspension may result in loss of school privileges (LOSP) 30 days prior to the event as outlined in the PUSD discipline policy.

B. Attendance/Tardies

A record of consistent attendance and being on time for all classes are requirements for participation in end-of-the-year 8th grade activities. (i.e. - no SART/SARB meetings)

Our hope is that every 8th Grade student will participate in all of the events that we have scheduled to celebrate our promoting class of 2024.

EVENT RULES
